- We establish a transparent value system that influences the building of a positive working environment;

SAFETY AND HEALTH (SH)

- We maintain a state of mature food safety culture in the area of manufactured food gases, medical gas safety in the area of manufactured and supplied medicinal products and medical devices, and occupational safety culture as key elements of organizational culture;
